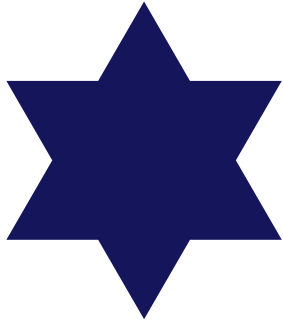

# From Jake Rubin, Executive Director



If you ask students why they love Hillel, most would respond with some variation on, “the community.” Of course there are other things they love (free food never hurts) but what keeps students coming back is the community. Students will tell you about the best friend they met, how our community helped them through a difficult time, or how they feel accepted. When students feel this way, it creates an environment where students feel comfortable to explore new ideas and think about Judaism in different ways.

This community and the centrality we place on creating it takes hard work, but it is the primary driver of Hillel at UVA’s success. One of the key ways we do this is through how we welcome and integrate new students into our community. This begins with outreach to new students, welcoming them to UVA, and introducing them to Hillel and the Jewish community. This past year we ran our first Camp WaJew, a pre-move-in retreat for first years to build their cohort and learn about UVA and Jewish life from upperclassmen. These students had an incredible experience and continued their involvement all year in significant ways. This year we had close to 40 students at Camp WaJew!

In addition to Camp WaJew, we host many events during Welcome Week and get first-years matched with their chutzpal, an upperclassman who can be a resource and friend as they navigate UVA. Another central component of our first-year experience is the Richard Glasser Hillel Jewish Leadership Institute (HJLI). HJLI is an eight-week seminar over dinner that explores leadership development, Jewish values, and practical skill building. Students end HJLI by pitching new and creative programs to meet the needs of current students. Working with staff and student leaders, implementing these new initiatives gives students real leadership experience.

Through these multiple initiatives, the Brody Jewish Center welcomes new students, helps them create community, and helps them find their place at Hillel and at UVA. Through this focus and intentional and strategic approach, Hillel can create a community that inspires students to make an enduring commitment to Judaism and the Jewish people both at UVA and beyond.

As always, I want to thank you. It is only through your generosity that we are able to do this incredibly important work. With your support, we are doing nothing short of creating a vibrant Jewish future for us all. I hope you enjoy reading about our exceptional students and the wonderful work they are doing on Grounds.

# How We Welcome

## **Tours and Admission Resources (Pre-Admission)**

BJC staff and students provide countless building tours, relaxed chats, and emailed resources to help prospective students understand the Jewish community here on Grounds and all it has to offer!

## **Camp WaJew Sign-ups (June)**

Sign-ups for our new early move-in immersive camp open for incoming First Years.

## **CAMP WAJEW (Week before Move-In)**

Debuting this past year, Camp Wajew is our most immersive welcome program. Students move into dorms early and then join our staff and upperclass students at a camp retreat for bonding, Jewish learning, and a mini-orientation for all things Hillel!

## **Days on the Lawn Tabling (Spring before First Year)**

Hillel tables during admitted student days to greet newly admitted Jewish students and get their contact information. This is how we begin to build our outreach list!

## **First Year Mailing (July)**

New students receive a big welcome packet from the BJC! We provide info on our programming, our students and staff, and even throw in some swag. This goes out to every new student we have info for!

## **Ongoing: Meeting incoming students and getting their contact information**

*Every year, the BJC has to build our list of incoming students from scratch. Finding our students is a challenge - but one we always give our all to! If you ever know a student coming to Grounds, please let us know so that we can get them connected.*

# First Year Students

## **Glasser Hillel Jewish Leadership Institute (Fall Semester)**

HJLI is an opportunity for First Year students to participate in a leadership and programming planning course that helps them understand the UVA Jewish community. With mentorship from BJC staff, students learn to identify needs, then put together program proposals they execute in the spring semester. After HJLI, the next generation of Hillel leaders are ready!

## **Engagement Coffee Dates (Throughout First Year)**

Our upperclass First Year Engagement Interns focus on engaging new students one-on-one, getting to know their passions and ensuring they have the support they need. The friendships they form allow our classes to connect and bond, making our community stronger.



## **Welcome Week (First week of classes)**

As classes begin, so does a week of exciting programming for the BJC, including our time-honored tradition of a BBQ at Hillel, Bagels on the Lawn, tabling at the activities fair, and class socials.



## **Shabbat Carpools (Every Shabbat)**

Because the BJC is a bit far from dorms, upperclass WaJews volunteer to drive students back and forth from our Shabbat programming throughout the year. Lovingly called "Jewber," this program helps make sure everyone can come to Shabbat.



## **Ongoing: Chutzpals Mentorship Program**

Throughout their first year, new WaJews are able to sign up for our Chutzpals mentorship program. They are paired with an upperclass student who meets with them and helps connect them with their passions, wherever those may take them across UVA! These students always become core members of our community.



# Programming Highlights



Our core program offerings of **Shabbat, Bagels on the Lawn, and Kvetch and Kvell** happen every week of the semester and are the cornerstones of our community. Students love these chances to consistently connect with the BJC community, and come back often throughout the year.

These programs give staff the opportunity to check in with students, support them, and give them a well deserved break during their busy college schedules. Shabbat and Bagels on the Lawn this year were consistently attended by over 100 students every single week!



**Birthright Israel** brings cohorts of UVA students to Israel together with BJC staff. Between our Winter Break and Summer trips, Hillel at UVA traveled with **89 students** and showed them all Israel has to offer! Birthright programming includes tours of Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, and

Safed, as well as a chance to float in the Dead Sea and take a Jeep tour in the Golan! Students travel with Israelis throughout the trip and BJC staff lead programming in the evenings to help the students process all they see and do. Birthright participants are some of the most active members of the community when they come back to UVA!



**Rabbi Jake led a Jewish learning course** for students weekly in the Spring semester. Students asked big questions and explored how they could connect with their Judaism.



**Fourth Year Questions** brought together the BJC's 4th year cohort for Jewish learning, graduation prep, and alumni networking. BJC staff helped them prepare for their next adventure!



Our Tikken Olam intern Trent and his team organized **volunteer days and charity fundraisers throughout the year**. Students helped clean up local parks and raised money for Jewish charities!
